CSU-Wide

Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive Program (CDIP): \$10,000/year while enrolled in a doctoral program. Must teach at CSU at completion of the doctorate.

At SF State

Graduate Equity Fellowship: For currently enrolled students up to \$2800.

Americorps: Community Service Learning in exchange for tuition. Up to approximately \$1100.

College Scholarship Program: For students of Hispanic heritage www.hsf.net

From the Department of Counseling

- Virginia Lee Block Scholarship: \$100 (variable amount given each year)
- Distinguished Student Award: \$1500 total per year (up to three students)
- Ida Sweeney Le Blanc Award: \$1000 each (three per year)
- 12th Step Scholarship: \$1000 each (three per year)
- Rehabilitation Counselor Training Program Scholarship: Stipend of \$500. Covers tuition costs or \$5328, whichever is less. Payback clause: upon graduation, work 2 years in public vocational rehabilitation system or at a non-profit rehabilitation agency for every year of receipt of award.
- Deaf, Deafened, and Hard of Hearing Program Scholarship: Stipend of \$7,500 per year. Payback clause: must work for the Department of Rehabilitation or Department of Rehabilitation related agency.
- School Counseling Fisher Scholarship: \$3000 (three students per year). 2nd year students only.
- MFT/Mental Health Services Act Scholarship: \$18,000 (competitive). 2nd year students only.
- Limited Research Assistantships to work with various faculty members.
